AMGA (American Medical Group Association): Advancing High ...

The SPI Course is a 27-hour training course that normally runs as three consecutive nine-hour days. It significantly improves the instructor's skill sets and integrates into the next level of training, the AMGA Rock Guide Course. The SPI Assessment is a minimum of 16 hours run over a two-day period and is separate from the course.

AMGA Single Pitch Instructor Course and Assessment

All course participants receive a written evaluation at the end of the course and are granted a one-year associate membership in the AMGA. Benefits of membership include a subscription to the quarterly Mountain Bulletin guide's newsletter, discounts on the AMGA Guide's Manual, and opportunities to attend membership instructional clinics and membership meetings.

For example, if I were exclusively a rock climber, I might consider becoming a Certified Rock Guide by beginning with my Rock Guide Course, then completing my Advanced Rock Guide Course, and finally taking my Rock Guide Exam.
