### INTAKE AND OUTPUT RECORD - IN.gov

One of the most difficult records to have accurately kept in routine hospital work is the "intake and output" chart. It was my aim to devise a chart that would at a glance give accurately the amount of all fluids ingested and the amount of urine excreted at individual hours throughout the day and night.

### The Ins and Outs of I&Os - Consult QD

When looking at 8-hour urine output, ask how many times the patient voided, to identify problems. For example, was a total of 300 ml from 2 voids of 150 ml, or from 10 voids of 30 ml each? Regard intake and output holistically because age, diagnosis, medical problem, and type of surgical procedure can affect the amounts.

Intake and Output (I/O) records in hospitals were often found to be incomplete and illegible. The form used to record I/O is not user-friendly — i.e., they feature miniscule boxes, "total" lines that do not correspond with shift changes and lack of instructions.
