Hospital (and Transplant Center) Requirements

The hospital must have a medical record service that has administrative responsibility for medical records. A medical record must be maintained for every individual evaluated or treated in the hospital. (a) Standard: Organization and staffing. The organization of the medical record service must be appropriate to the scope and complexity of the services performed.

Interpretive Guidelines §482.13(e): The intent of this standard is to identify patients' basic rights, ensure patient safety, and eliminate the inappropriate use of restraint or seclusion.

42 CFR § 482.24 - Condition of participation: Medical ...

A hospital must protect and promote each patient's rights. (a) Standard: Notice of rights - (1) A hospital must inform each patient, or when appropriate, the patient's representative (as allowed under State law), of the patient's rights, in advance of furnishing or discontinuing patient care whenever possible. (2) The hospital must establish a process for prompt resolution of patient ...
