The starting position of the Japanese abacus is shown above, where all 5-unit counters are stacked at the top, and all 1-unit counters are stacked at the bottom.

The soroban (算盤, 算盤, counting tray) is an abacus developed in Japan. It is derived from the ancient Chinese suanpan, imported to Japan in the 14th century. Like the suanpan, the soroban is still used today, despite the proliferation of practical and affordable pocket electronic calculators
