I don't even bother to stick with one brand. I've used a lot of Mobil Delvac in my Kubota and Dodge Cummins because I can get it on sale in 5-gallon buckets.

## **Kubota SAE 15W-40 Engine Oil (1 Gallon) - Coleman Equipment**

Kubota suggests that you change the oil on your Kubota tractor every 75 to 120 hours. It is advised that you review the owner's manual for exact service intervals. Doing due diligence and checking the owner's manual for your Kubota tractor will also provide you with information on the part number of the replacement oil filter that you will need as well as the oil capacity of the engine that powers the tractor.

Internal Engine Oil Engine oil in Kubota diesels should be monitored on a regular basis, and you must have the right oil. It is recommended to use 30W or 10W-40 in temperature conditions that are above 77 degrees Fahrenheit, 20W or 10W-30 in temperatures that range from 32 to 77 degrees, and 10W or 10W-30 for temperatures below 32 degrees.

Depending on the model, Kubota recommends regular oil changes every 75-150 hours (less for construction or heavy use). Check your operator's manual for the exact service interval. Something else you will find in your reference manuals are 1) the part number for a replacement oil filter and 2) the oil capacity of the engine.
