Apply for Heating and Cooling Assistance (HEAP)

Income Limits. The HEAP income limits are published on the New York Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance website. Households are only eligible if the income falls below the specified limits based on the household size. For example, 2014-2015 guidelines limit a family of three to a monthly gross income of \$3,544.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) - ACCESS NYC

The NYS Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is a federally funded program that assists low-income New Yorkers in meeting their home energy needs. The HEAP program is comprised of Regular Benefit, Emergency Benefit, Furnace Repair/Replacement, and Weatherization components.

Erie County Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) program is designed to provide financial assistance to eligible households with their winter heating costs. The Office for the Aging assists people who are 60 and over or are disabled with their HEAP. A one time benefit is applied directly toward winter's fuel costs.

Regular HEAP applications for households that did not receive a HEAP benefit in 2010-11 will not be made available until November 19, 2012. Regular HEAP benefits are based on income, the primary fuel source and the presence of a household member who is under age 6, age 60 or older or permanently disabled.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) - New York

Eligibility for the program is based on income (see income guidelines below) and housing situation. Individuals must either pay directly for heating costs or pay rent that includes heating costs and must be a U.S. citizen or a qualified alien to apply. HEAP money is limited.

The individual must also have a Social Security number and gross monthly income and resources that do not exceed the applicable limits for the program. For a disabled or elderly (age 60 or over) individual whose gross income exceeds 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL), the resource limit is \$3,500.
