He erected one on an island near Mossel Bay, South Africa, two in Mozambique, and one in Calicut, India, to prove that his fleet—two three-masted sailing ships, a 50-ton caravel, and a 200-ton storeship—had been there.

Here Vasco da Gama arrived in 1498 after his intrepid voyage round Che Cape of Good Hope and across the Indian Ocean. He landed with thirteen comrades and visited the Zamorin, the Hindu ruler of Calicut. Da Gama was treated with courtesy, but trouble arose later and was not quelled until da Gama had returned from Portugal with a powerful fleet.
